Risk register template structure

1. RISK IDENTIFICATION SECTION

- Risk ID: Unique identifier (e.g., R-001)
- Risk name: Brief title of the risk
- Risk description: Detailed description of the risk and its potential consequences
- Risk category: Strategic, operational, financial, compliance, technical, etc.
- · Date identified: When the risk was first recognized
- Risk source: Internal or External

2. RISK ASSESSMENT SECTION

- **Probability/likelihood:** Rating (1-5 scale)
 - 1: Rare (0-10% chance)
 - 2: Unlikely (10-30% chance)
 - 3: Possible (30-50% chance)
 - 4: Likely (50-70% chance)
 - 5: Almost certain (70-100% chance)
- Impact severity: Rating (1-5 scale)
 - 1: Negligible
 - 2: Minor
 - 3: Moderate
 - 4: Maior
 - 5: Catastrophic
- Risk score: Probability × Impact (1-25)
- **Priority level:** High (15-25), medium (8-14), low (1-7)
- Asset criticality: Rating of how critical the affected asset is (1-5)

3. RISK RESPONSE SECTION

- Response strategy: Accept, transfer, mitigate or eliminate
- Response plan: Detailed actions to implement the chosen strategy
- Required resources: Budget, personnel and other resources needed
- **Timeline:** Expected completion dates for response actions
- **Success criteria:** How to measure if the response is effective

4. RISK OWNERSHIP AND MONITORING SECTION

- Risk owner: Person responsible for managing this risk
- **Stakeholders:** Other parties affected by or involved with this risk
- Review frequency: How often this risk should be reassessed
- Current status: Open, in progress, closed, monitoring
- Last review date: When the risk was last assessed
- **Next review date:** When the risk should be reviewed again
- Status notes: Updates on risk management activities

5. COST TRACKING SECTION

- **Estimated response cost:** Projected budget for risk response
- Actual cost to date: Current spending on risk management
- Cost variance: Difference between estimated and actual costs
- **Time spent:** Hours dedicated to managing this risk
